## SGB Governor Awards

### SGB Gold (1)

**Value:** \$150

**Deadline:** March 31st

**Eligibility:** Awarded to an SGB Governor

**Criteria:**

- Be an elected member of the Board of Governors during the academic year
- Demonstrate strong leadership skills and professionalism
- Takes initiatives in the execution of duties/ responsibilities

### SGB Silver (1)

**Value:** \$100

**Deadline:** March 31st

**Eligibility:** Awarded to an SGB Governor

**Criteria:**

- Be an elected member of the Board of Governors during the academic year

- Takes initiatives in the execution of duties/ responsibilities

### SGB Bronze (1)

**Value:** \$75

**Deadline:** March 31st

**Eligibility:** Awarded to an SGB Governor

**Criteria:**

- Takes initiatives in the execution of duties/ responsibilities

## Student Awards

### SAKC Student of The Year Award (1)

**Value:** \$1,000

**Deadline:** March 31st

**Eligibility:** Awarded to a student who has been enrolled in a full-time capacity. Executives of the Association in the year considered will not be eligible.

**Criteria:** Awarded to the student who most demonstrates outstanding contributions and leadership in the field of student affairs and academics. The recipient of this award will have performed at a level well above the requirements of that individual's position. The Applicant must also have a minimum GPA of 2.0.

### SAKC Spirit Award (3)

**Value:** \$500

**Deadline:** March 31st

**Eligibility:** Awarded to a member of the SAKC

**Criteria:** Based on a dedication to student affairs. The recipient of this award would have continually been involved in student activities, and/or committees of the Association. Recipients will be selected based on their ability to effectively convey their enthusiasm and SAKC pride within their application. The Awards Selection Committee will select three successful applicants.

**Application Process:** Applicants are asked to create a tagline or motto for SAKC Spirit. Applicants are also required to include a personal reflection on what being a part of the SAKC community means to them and how participating in SAKC activities has contributed to their sense of community and pride at Keyano.

Applicants may include statements on why they initially chose Keyano, what events they have attended, ideas they have to promote and foster school spirit in others, how they have participated and contributed to the SAKC community, etc.
